It has been an amazing month. The children have been hard at work writing, creating, singing and playing. Our daily helpers (calendar helper, flag holder, etc .) take their jobs very seriously and it's wonderful to see each child take pride and ownership in his/her responsibilities.

There are many important parts to Pre-K curriculum and getting your child ready for kindergarten for the following year.

Some components we will cover during the school year are:

- ♦ Academic: Letter and number (1-30) formation and concepts.
- ♦ Social/Emotional skills: Making friends, being kind, taking turns, listening to your peers, cooperative play, communicating with peers.
- ♦ Circle Time: Being attentive, participating in singing, answering questions, waiting turns to speak, not bothering friends.
- ♦ Following Directions/Rules: Listening to the teachers, staying on task at work centers and remembering the outside rules.

October and fall is upon us! This month is all about this wonderful season. We will discuss 'fall', leaves, animals, apples and pumpkins. At the end of this month we will be carving pumpkins. If you would like to donate pumpkins for carving, we need 3 large pumpkins. We also need each family to bring a small to medium pumpkin for their child to decorate.
